The symposium will introduce the TRANSCEND approach to peaceful conflict transformation. The basic assumption is the peace discourse rather than the security discourse. Untransformed conflict is seen as the basic cause of violence at the micro, meso, macro and mega levels. The focus will be on approaches to mediation and conciliation, with many examples, including such major current conflicts as Anglo-America vs. Arabia/Christianity-West vs. Islam, with Iraq and Iran as special cases, Israel-Palestine, Sri Lanka and other places where the resource person has mediation-conciliation experience, and exercises.
